

Porter Heath Morgan is an attorney and filmmaker. His most recent work, "The Trials of Law School," is a feature length documentary about law school that will be released this spring. The film follows nine students through law school and features interviews from highly recognized law professors from around the country, including Taunya Banks from the University of Maryland College of Law. Mr. Morgan has also produced several short documentary productions including "Peevyhouse v.
