



Submitting video projects via blackboard

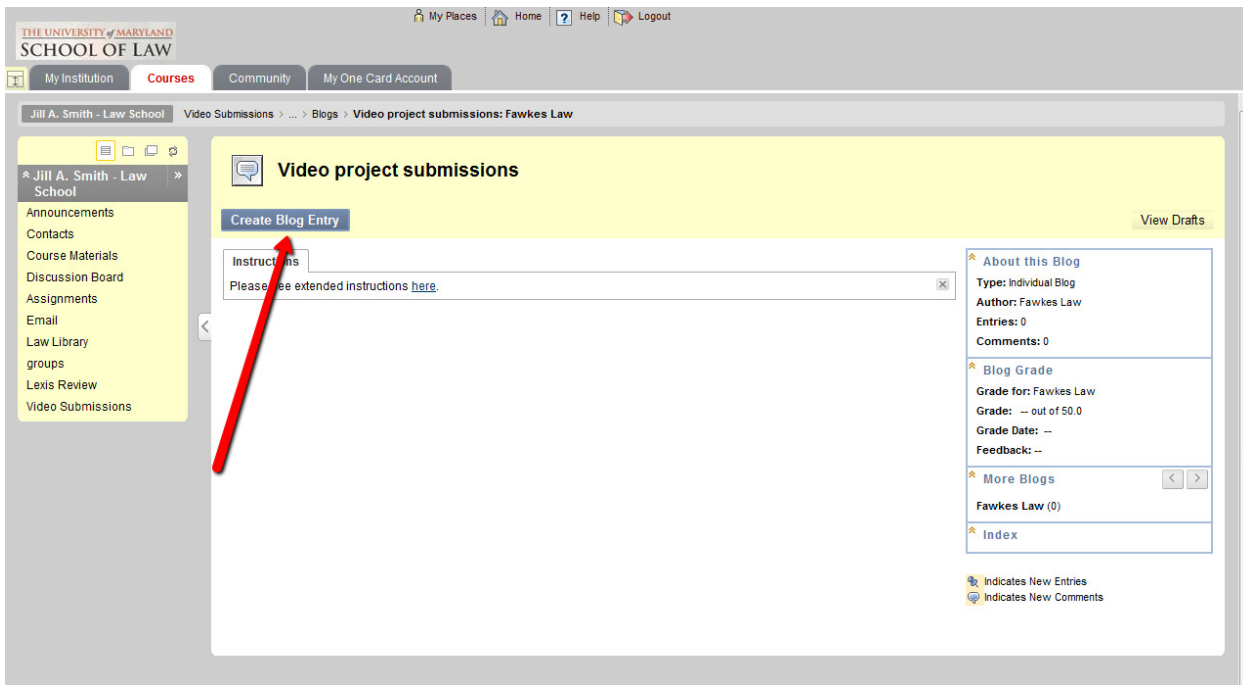

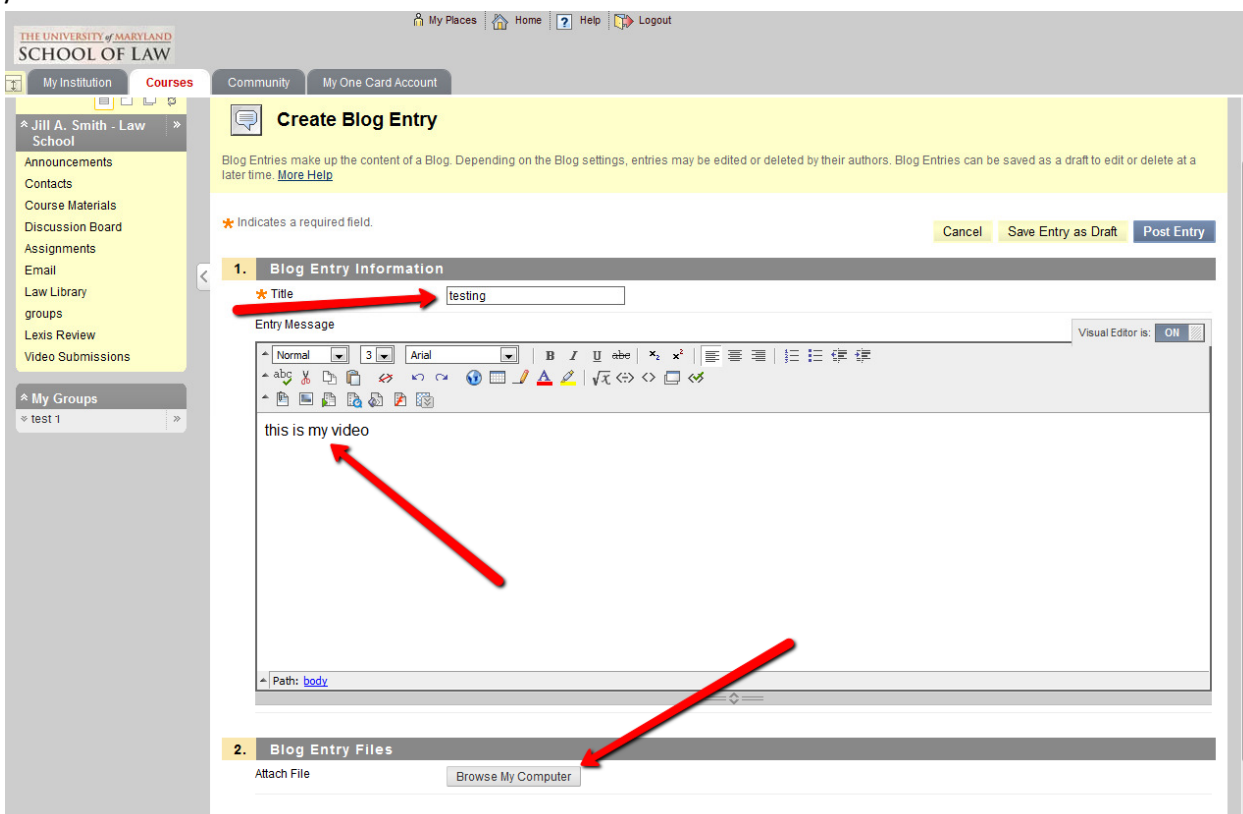

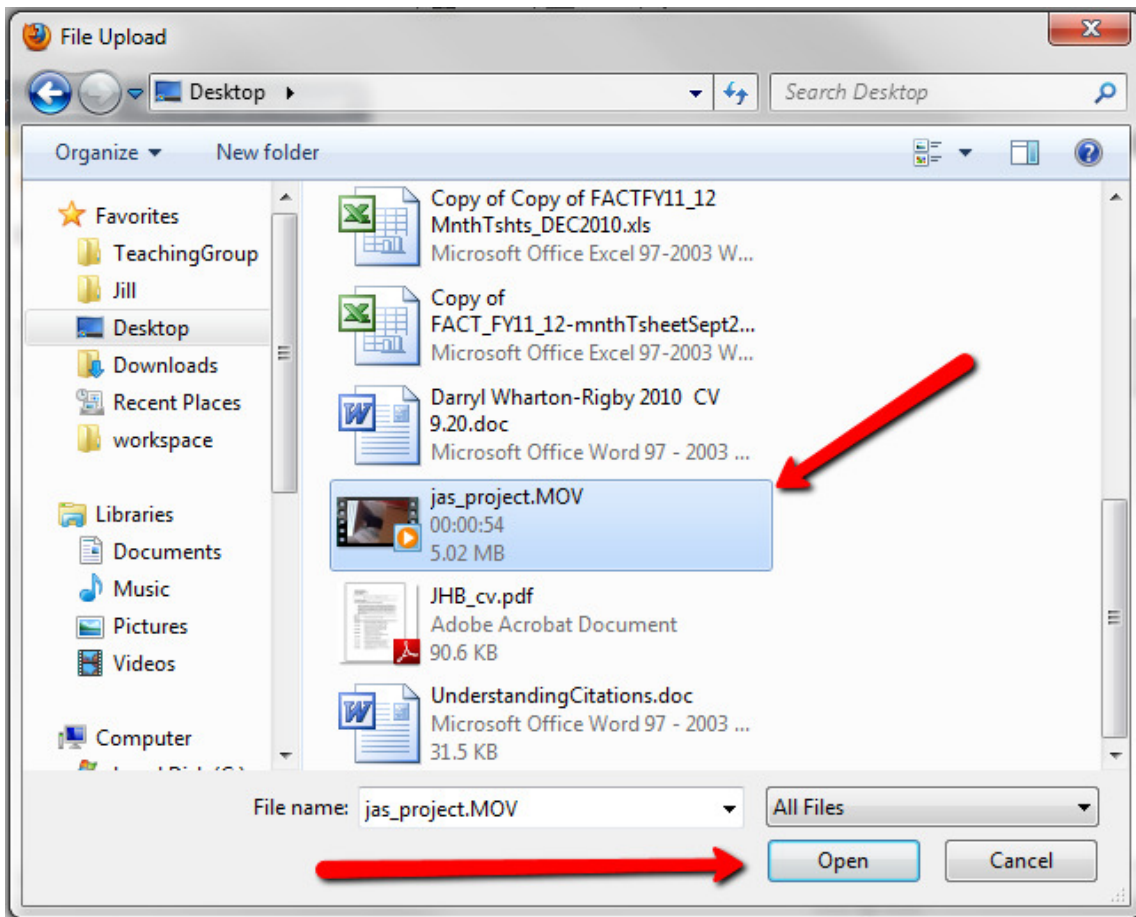
Click "Create Blog Entry"



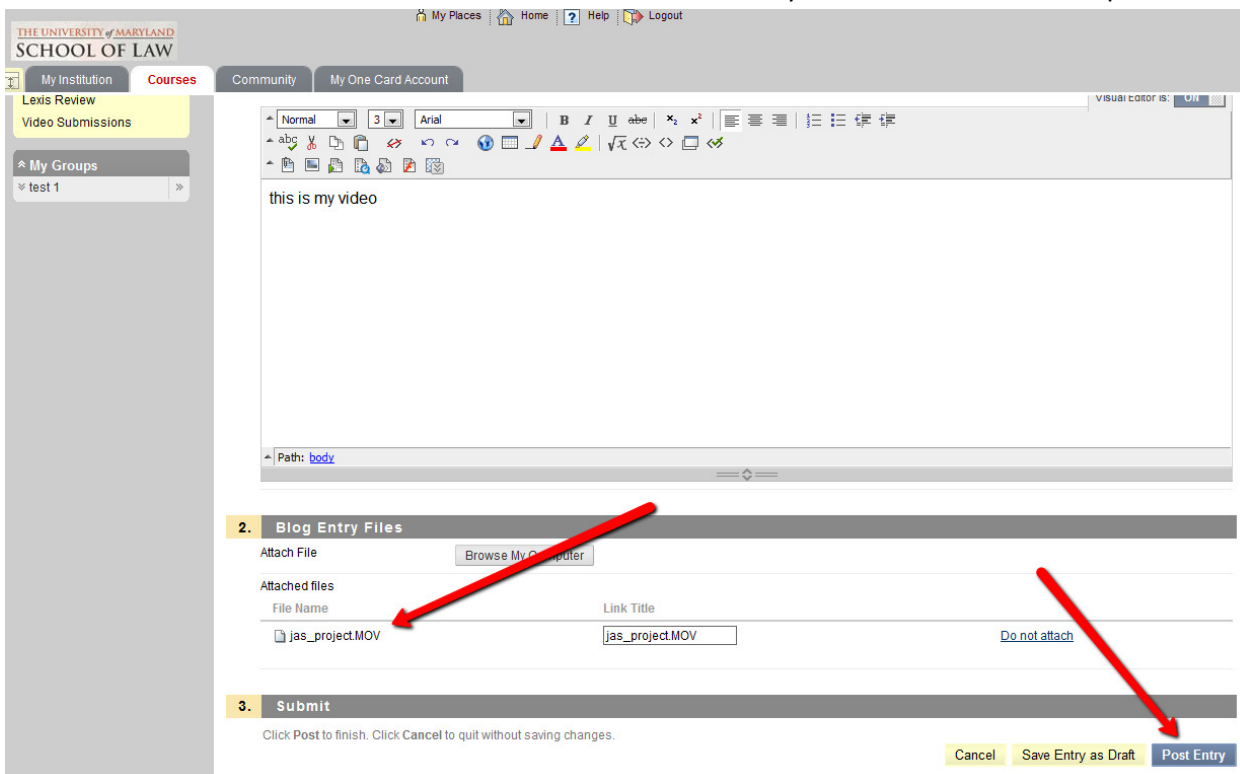
Enter a title (required), add any explanatory notes if you would like, and click "Browse my Computer" to find and upload your video file.
