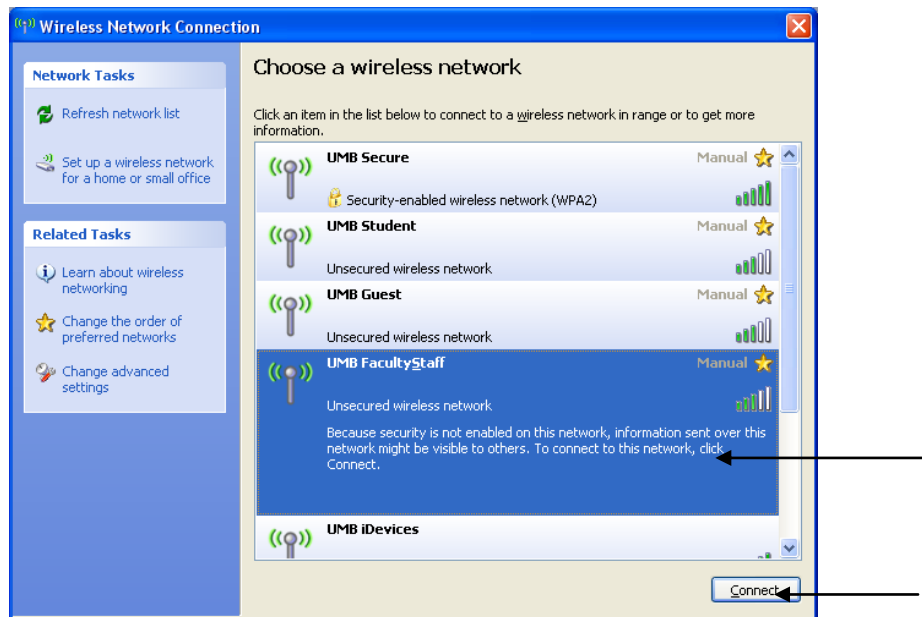
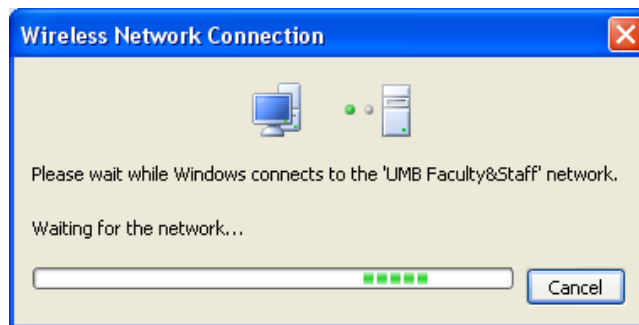

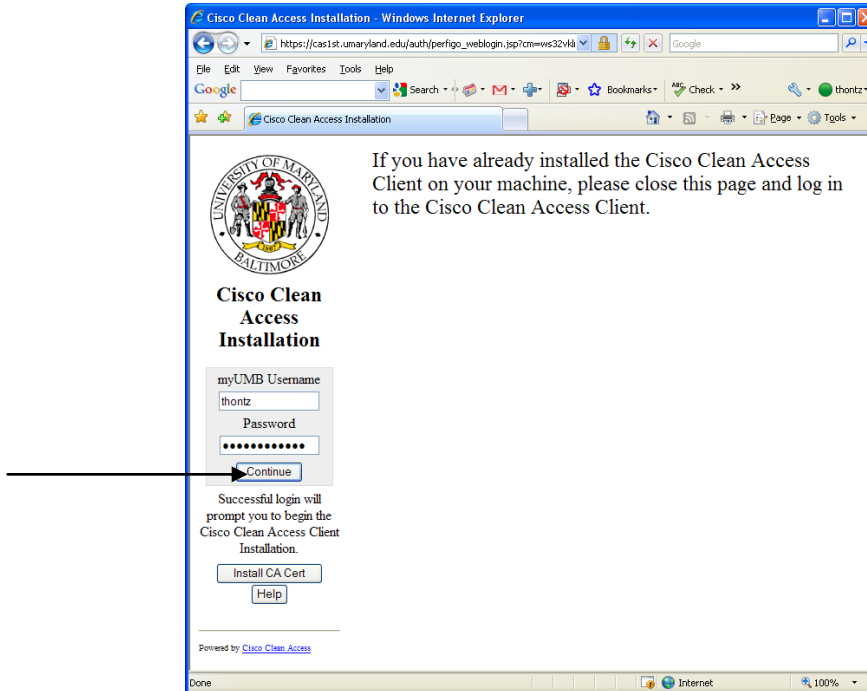
1. View your available wireless networks, select UMB Faculty&Staff, then click on Connect



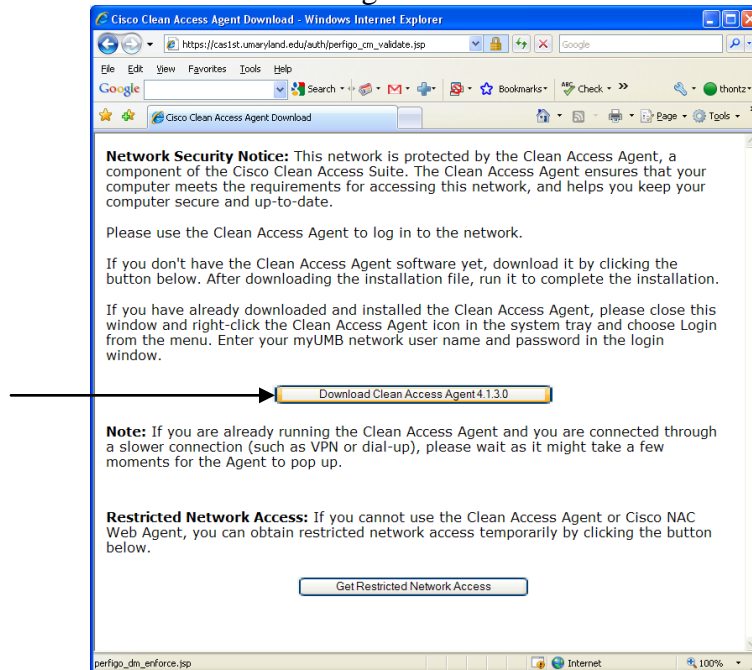
You will see the following connection screen during the connection attempt.



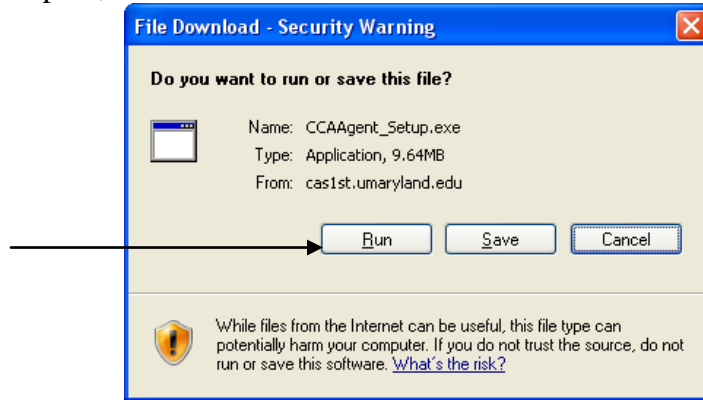
2. Once connected open Internet Explorer and you will see the Cisco Clean Access Installation screen. Enter your MyUMB Username and password then click on Continue.



3. Click on Download Clean Access Agent 4.1.3.0



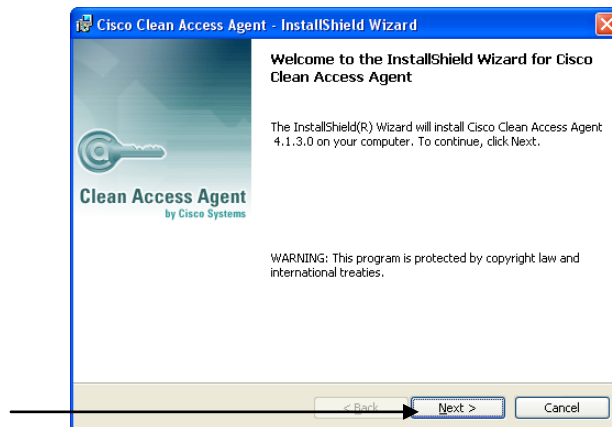
4. When prompted, click on Run



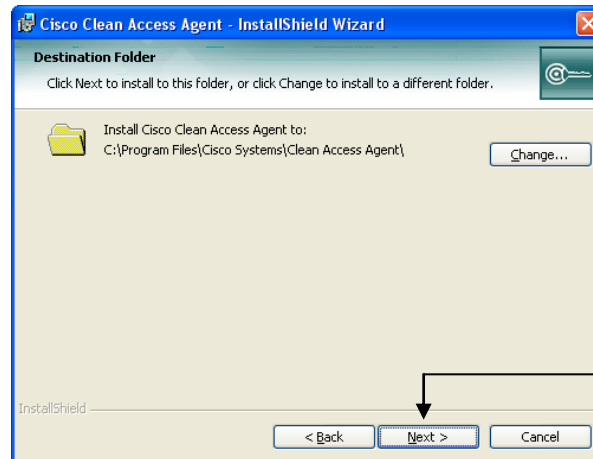
If prompted, click on Run



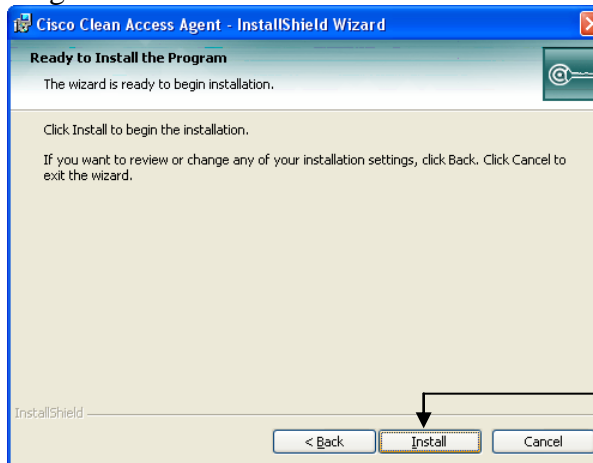
5. Click on Next

10. You may be prompted to install a Clean Access upgrade. If prompted click on OK.



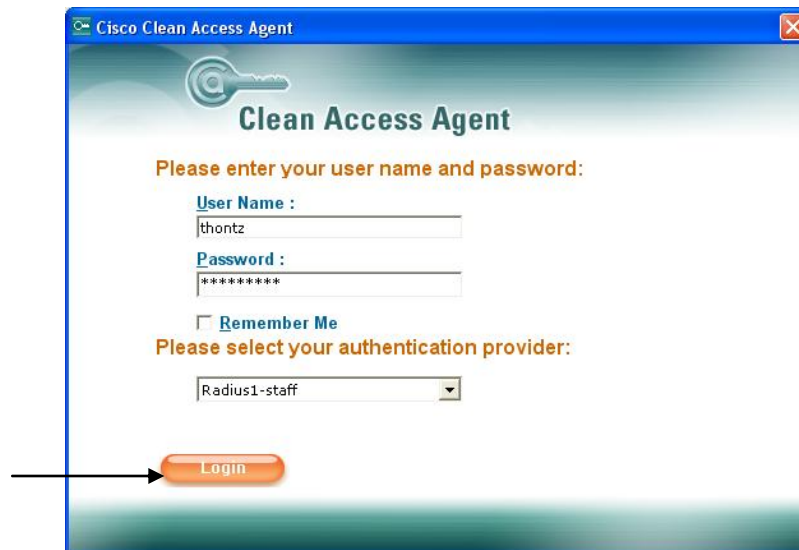
11. Click on Next

13. Enter your myUMB Username and Password. Click on Login



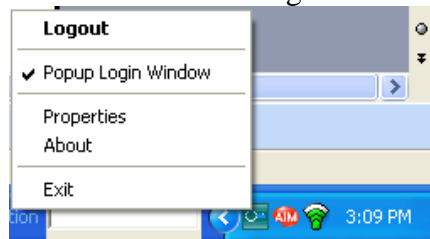
14. Once connected you will see the following message. Click on OK.



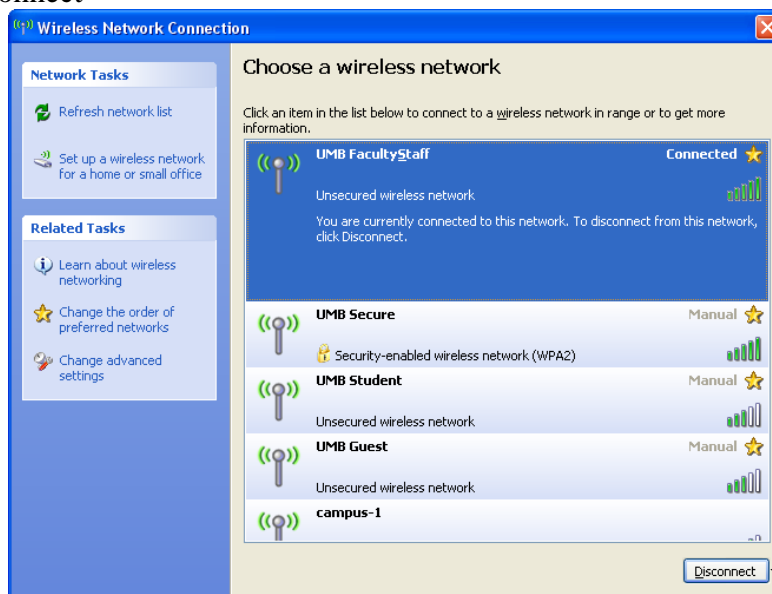
15. When you are finished using the wireless network be sure to log out of Clean Access. To log out, right click on the Cisco Clean Access icon



Then click Logout

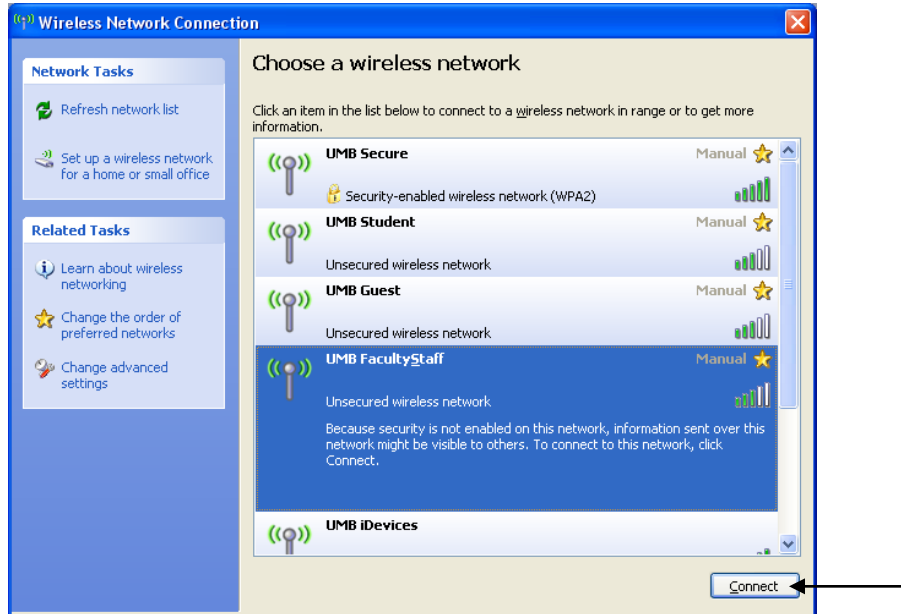


16. Open the Windows Wireless network Connection, select UMB Faculty&Staff, then click Disconnect

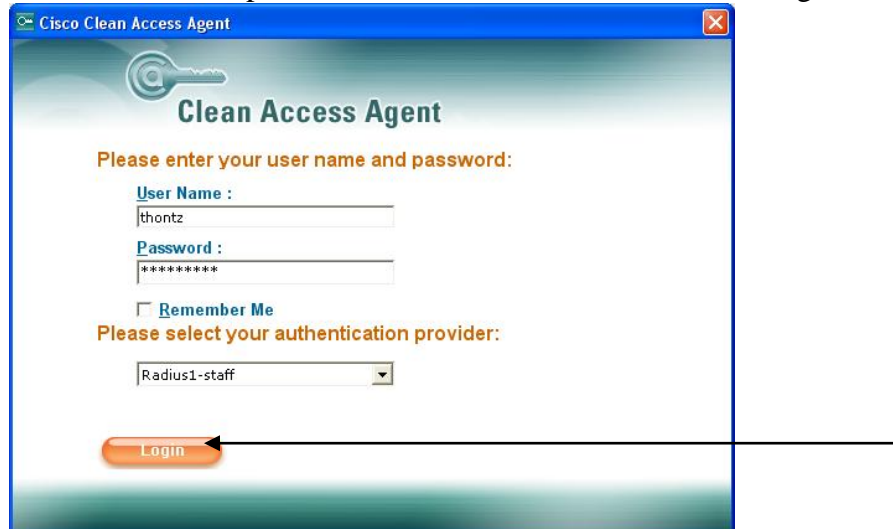


Future connections to the secure wireless network will only require the following steps:

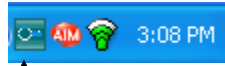
1. Open the Windows Wireless Network Client, select UMB Faculty&Staff, then click Connect.



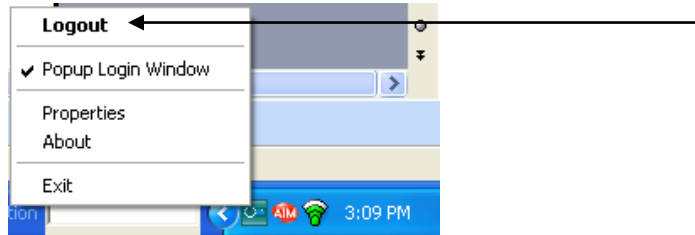
2. Do not open Internet Explorer yet. The Cisco Clean Access Agent will start and prompt you to authenticate. Enter your myUMB User Name and password. Leave the Please select your authentication provider: at the default selection. Click Login.
