**SENIOR WILD CARD COURSE SELECTION FORM**  
**SPRING 2010** (10/28/09)

Seniors who submitted a Wild Card form in April may not submit another Wild Card choice. Seniors who did not submit a Wild Card in April may submit this form to the Office of Registration and Enrollment, Suite 280 by **6:00 p.m. Monday, November 2** to obtain Wild Card priority. Forms may be faxed to (410) 706-2103 (not responsible for faxes not received). For the number of openings in these offerings see "Openings in Spring 2010 Courses after Senior Wild Card & Clinic/LTP/CARDIN Selections in April 2008." Students requesting a place in a spring clinic or LTP course (a spring '09 Wild Card cannot 'bump' those already admitted or on the wait list) must also submit the Clinic/LTP/Cardin Preference Form.

See the Advance Registration Memorandum for a full description for enrollment priorities. Course descriptions (including pre- and co-requisite requirements) may be found in the online Course Catalog.

At this Wild Card stage, each prospective spring 2010 graduate who has not previously submitted a Wild Card request receives one priority for the entire academic year, beginning with the summer session. You may use this selection form to rank four courses in order of preference (#1 through #4) for any course offering in Spring 2010, **except as follows**:

1. Asper Fellowship, Center for Health & Homeland Security Externship, Clinic II, Externships, Health Law Practicum, Independent Written Work, Intellectual Property Law Practicum, International and Comparative Law Clinic, Legislative/Congressional Practicum and Workshop, Maryland Legislative Practicum, South Africa Externship, Teaching Fellow Seminar, and Women, Leadership & Equality Fellows Practicum are not subject to Wild Card or other normal selection processes; enrollment is determined by the instructor.
2. Wild Card cannot be used for courses in which **non-seniors have priority**, Business Associations, Evidence, Income Taxation, and Trial Planning & Advocacy.
3. Wild Card cannot be used for courses in which **first-year students have priority** for spring electives, Administrative Law (Schwartz), Bioethics Seminar/Course, Comparative Public Policy & Law Reform, Intellectual Property Aspects of Business Law, International Law (Danchin), Jurisprudence Seminar (Gray), Introduction to Regulatory System Seminar, Legal Profession (Harner), Legal Profession/Reasoning & Rhetoric, and South Africa: Race & the Law Seminar.
4. Seniors choosing a Clinic or LTP course as their selection also must submit the Clinic/LTP/Cardin Preference Form.
5. Day students **may not Wild Card evening clinics**: Appellate Advocacy Clinic, Low Income Taxpayers Clinic and Mediation Clinic.
