**Criteria:** The Dean's Awards are designed to recognize students who have a demonstrated record of law school leadership in co-curricular activities, student organizations, and/or public service originating within the law school. All applicants must be School of Law degree candidates, in good academic standing, who have completed one year of law school. Transfer students who have completed one year at this law school may apply. Visiting and guest students are not eligible.

**N.B.** Students who received grant/scholarship awards of at least \$5,000 in a single year are not eligible to participate in this program. (Loan funds will not count against your eligibility.) Any amount, which together with the student's financial aid award is more than the student's demonstrated need, may require that the student's financial aid award be reduced.

**Please note:** The Honor Code applies to all Dean's award submissions.
