The University of Maryland School of Law is a participating institution in the Yellow Ribbon Program, which was established to address the deficit in G.I. Bill benefits facing eligible Maryland law students.

Incoming and current Maryland law students are eligible to apply for program funds. Priority in selection of recipients is given on a first-come, first served basis—in accordance to the requirements set forth by the Veteran’s Administration—determined by the date **THIS APPLICATION** is received.

Applicants must file this application, along with:

- G.I. Bill Award Certification showing proof that applicant is eligible to receive the maximum benefit rate (i.e. 100% benefits).

The first ten (10) eligible students to have their forms submitted will receive up to a \$1,300 grant from the University of Maryland School of Law for the purpose of covering tuition, which, per the terms of the Yellow Ribbon Program, will be matched by the Veteran’s Administration for a maximum potential award of \$2,600. The University of Maryland School of Law will not prioritize full-time versus part-time students, as this would violate the terms of agreement of the program.
