Maryland Public Schools Arrest Data

School Year 2015-2016

Background

- Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 13A.08.01.12 – Arrests on School Premises
 - Requires annual reporting of school arrests to MSDE.
 - First data collection covered school year 2015-2016.



Definitions

- □ School Arrest:
 - An arrest that occurred as a result of a referral of a student by school personnel to law enforcement or DJS.
 - Offense occurred on school grounds or during off-campus activities, including transportation.
 - Can be "physical" or "paper".



Definitions (continued)

- Physical arrest: a student is physically placed under arrest by a law enforcement official.
- Paper arrest: an officer-initiated referral or request for charges by school officials to DJS (e.g. Juvenile Offense Report or Citation for Court Appearance).



Reportable Offenses

- Offenses for which students are arrested in the community.
- Law enforcement must notify the local superintendent and school principal.
- Reportable offenses are not reported to MSDE and are not included in the report.



Maryland Arrest Report

□ Components

 State Report – Arrests by LEA, school level, gender, race, grade, special education, English Learner, suspension in conjunction with arrest, type (in-school or out of school), length, offense, location, arresting officer (local police or school resource officer), days suspended.



Maryland Arrest Report

□ Components (continued)

- Local Report contains same elements as previous bullet but at the local level.
- State Race and Gender Report lists arrests by race, gender, and school level for arresting offenses.
- Local Race and Gender Report contains same elements as previous bullet but at the local level.



Maryland Arrest Report

- Note: In instances where the number of students in a given cell was less than 10, the data were removed and replaced with an asterisk to protect student identity.
