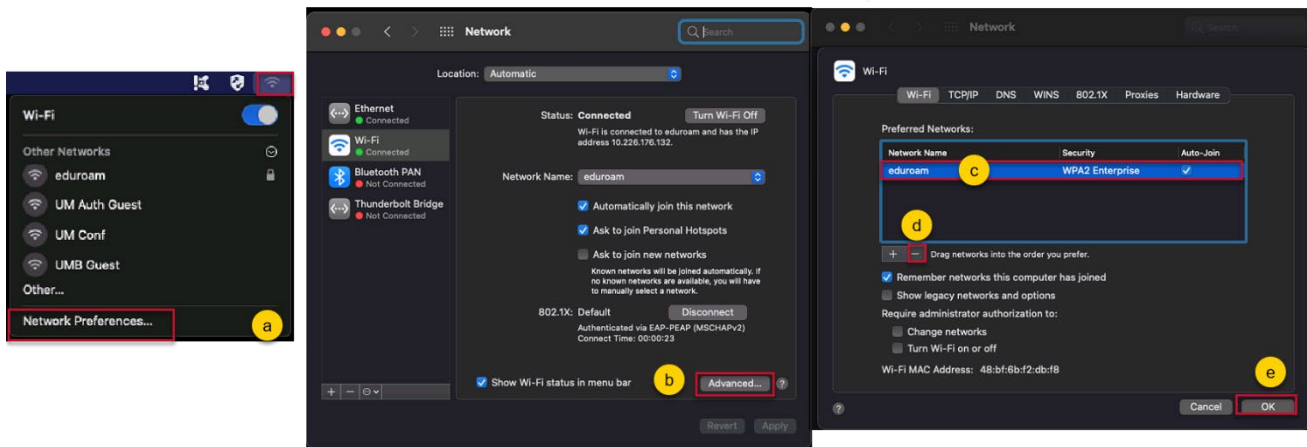
Connecting to UMB Eduroam (Windows 10):

- 1.) Connect your laptop or other device to the wireless network named **“Eduroam”**.
- 2.) When prompted for your username/password, use your full @umaryland email address & password
- 3.) When prompted to continue connecting, click continue. This will install UMB’s Eduroam certificate on your laptop.
- 4.) You are now connected to the internet.

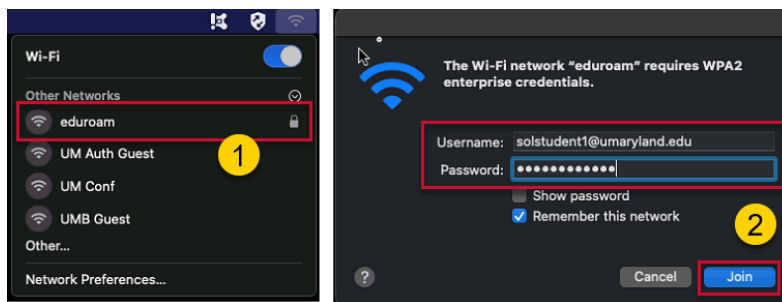

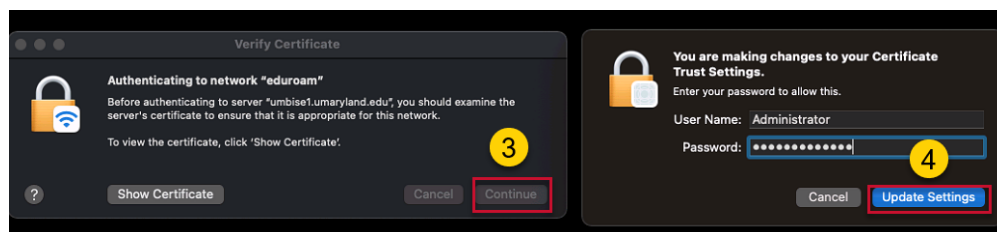


Connecting to UMB Eduroam (macOS):

- 1.) Select Eduroam network from the list of available wireless networks
- 2.) Enter your full @umaryland email/address password. Click “Join”



- 3.) Click “Continue” to accept UMB’s certificate.
- 4.) If prompted, enter your admin credentials to install the UMB certificate on your laptop.
